This document will go over the symbols that can be found throughout ATS and what they mean/do.



Clicking on this image allows you to add items to the drop-down list shown next to it “on the fly” You must be an administrator or have administrative access to the drop down menus for this.



Clicking on this image will display information we feel will be helpful when using the current screen.



Clicking this image will copy the name and address for the applicable information to the clipboard.



Clicking on this image will print a detail of the report for the data on the current screen.



Clicking on this image will spellcheck the note on the current screen.




Clicking on this image enters the current time in the applicable field using the HH:MM pm format.



Clicking on this image will display the applicable athlete's information screen.



Clicking on this button will allow you to insert a “tag” field marker into your note or note template.




Clicking on this image processes/loads the information associated with the tags in the applicable note.

Clicking on this displays the “Last Activity” for current injuries.


The following symbols are found in the Reports Menu.
