

ATS— Quick Modality Overview

Date and time box. Will default to current day/time but may be changed

User entering data.

Filter which patients/athletes you see. All injured, kiosk logins for the date, patient portal logins for the date, or athletes on a team/season.

Choose the injury you are entering the modality for

What time the modalities were entered

Assign a new default injury. Default injury allows you to log day to day, general ice bags, heat and e-stim or ankle taping when no injury is present.

Allows you to view injury details after selecting the injury above.

After selecting the patient/athlete to the left, this button will take you to the patient/athlete details screen.
