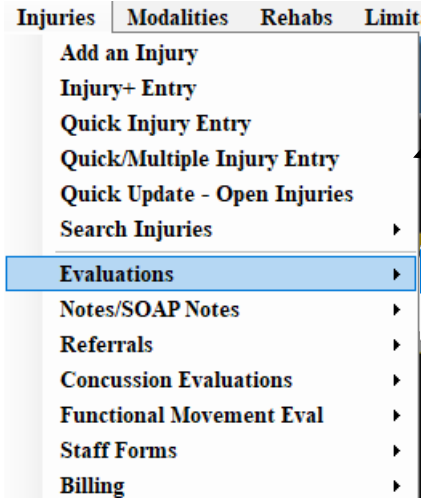


ATS: Injury Evaluation Overview

ATS does provide a standard injury evaluation area. This allows for a consistent documentation for every injury for all users. There are two ways to access the Evaluations area. Under the Injury Menu and from an individual injury profile. The first half will go through the Core version the second half will go over the Core Portal version.

Core

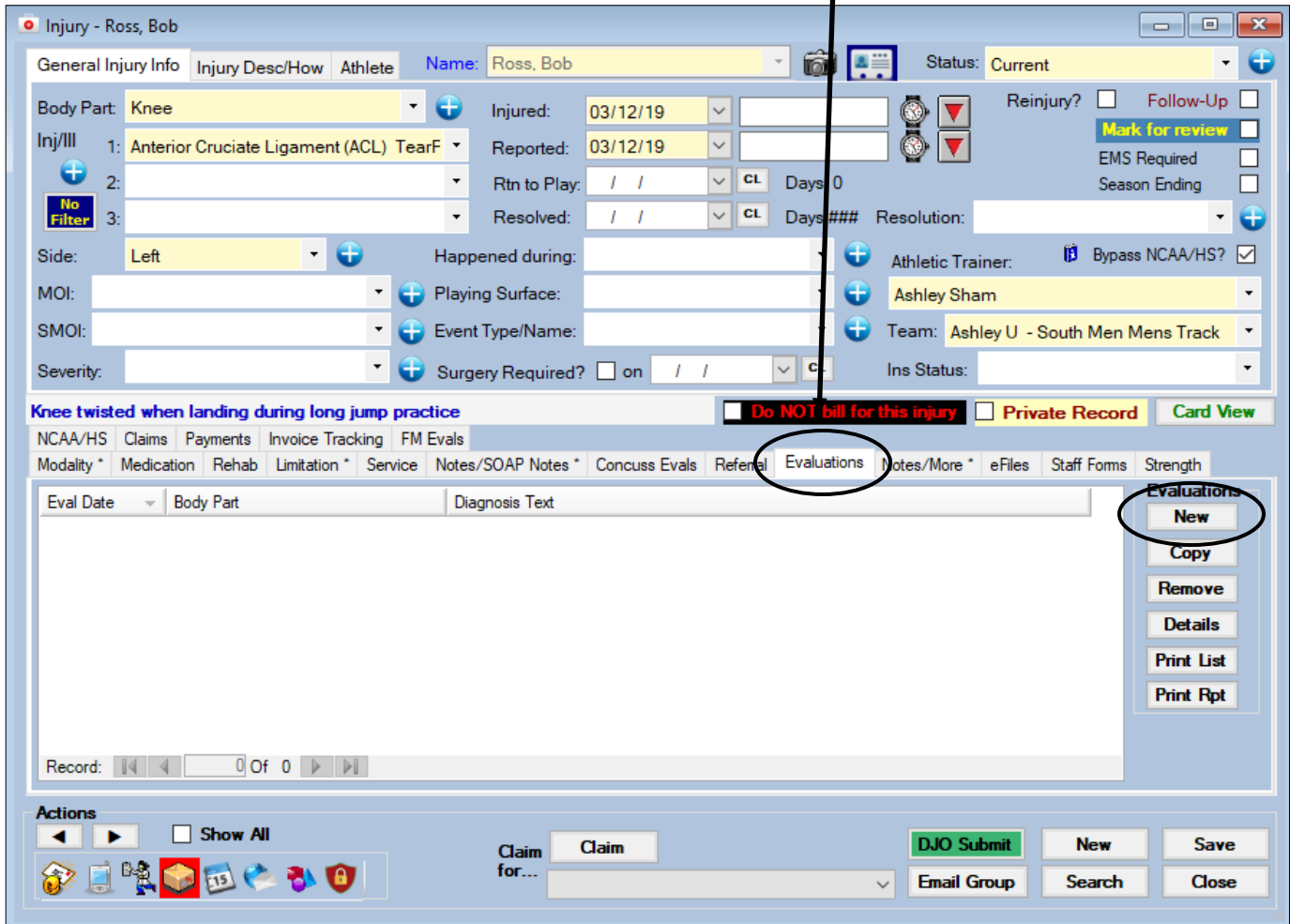


From the Menu select Injuries—>Evaluations—> add an Evaluation.

If you have the injury profile open simply select the Evaluations tab. You can load previous evals or begin a new one by selecting the New button.

The evaluation has several tabs associated with it, this doc will go through all the available tabs.

The colored boxes show you the corresponding popup list to edit the selections. Admin—>maintenance—>dropdown/popup list—>update dropdown/popup list.

General

The athletes name, injury, the date and the ATC doing the evaluation will all automatically load at the top.

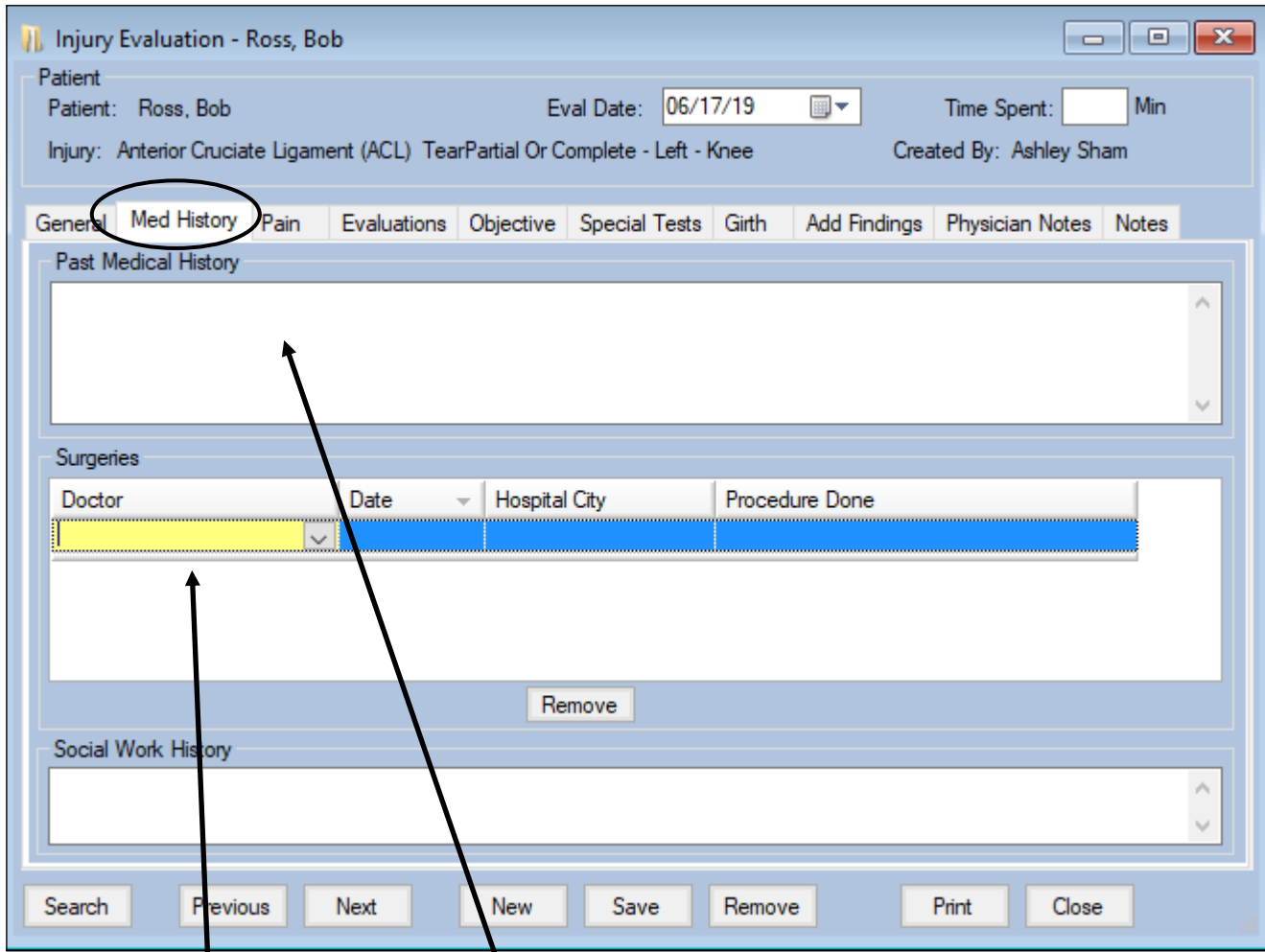
If your Organization is involved in Billing or tracking of the ICD codes in anyway you can fill that information in here as well as choose the billing provider.

There is an area for you to fill in the history taken as well as document any medications if necessary.

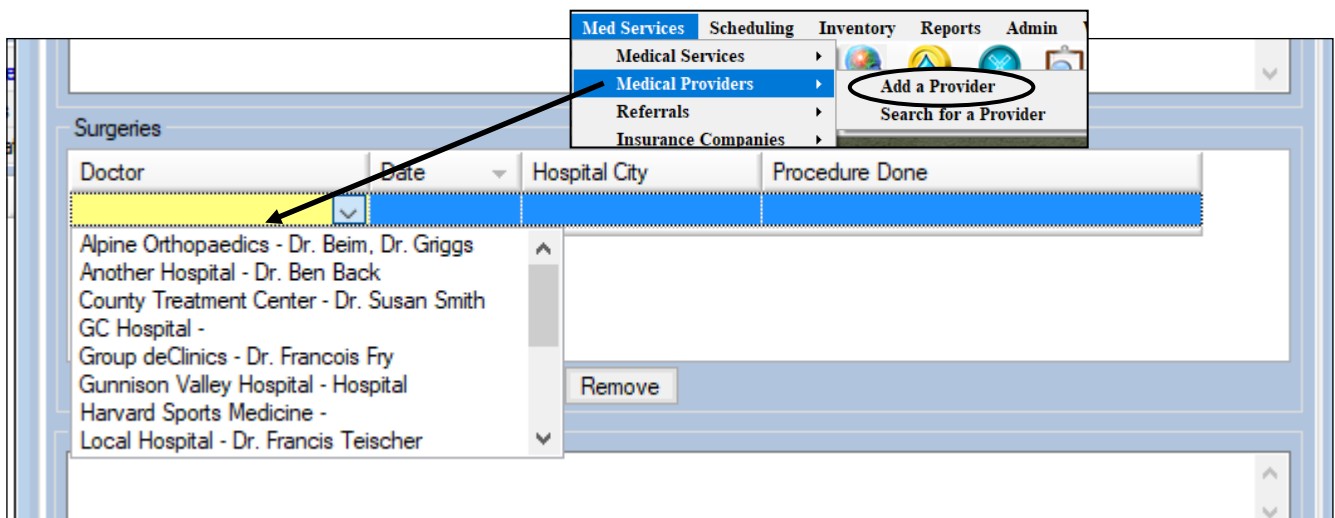

This tab can be used for a more detailed Medical History. With sections for your to type in answers to your questions and document any prior surgeries.

The list of doctors available in the drop down menu is pulled from the list of medical providers in your database. To add, follow the picture below.

Pain

The Pain tab lets you document information about the athlete and their pain. This area is completed via drop down options. The options available in the drop down areas are custom to your database. See your system administrator to add choices.

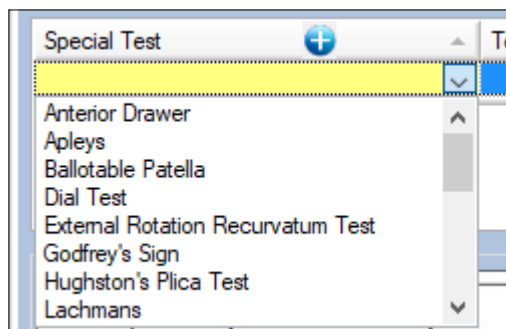
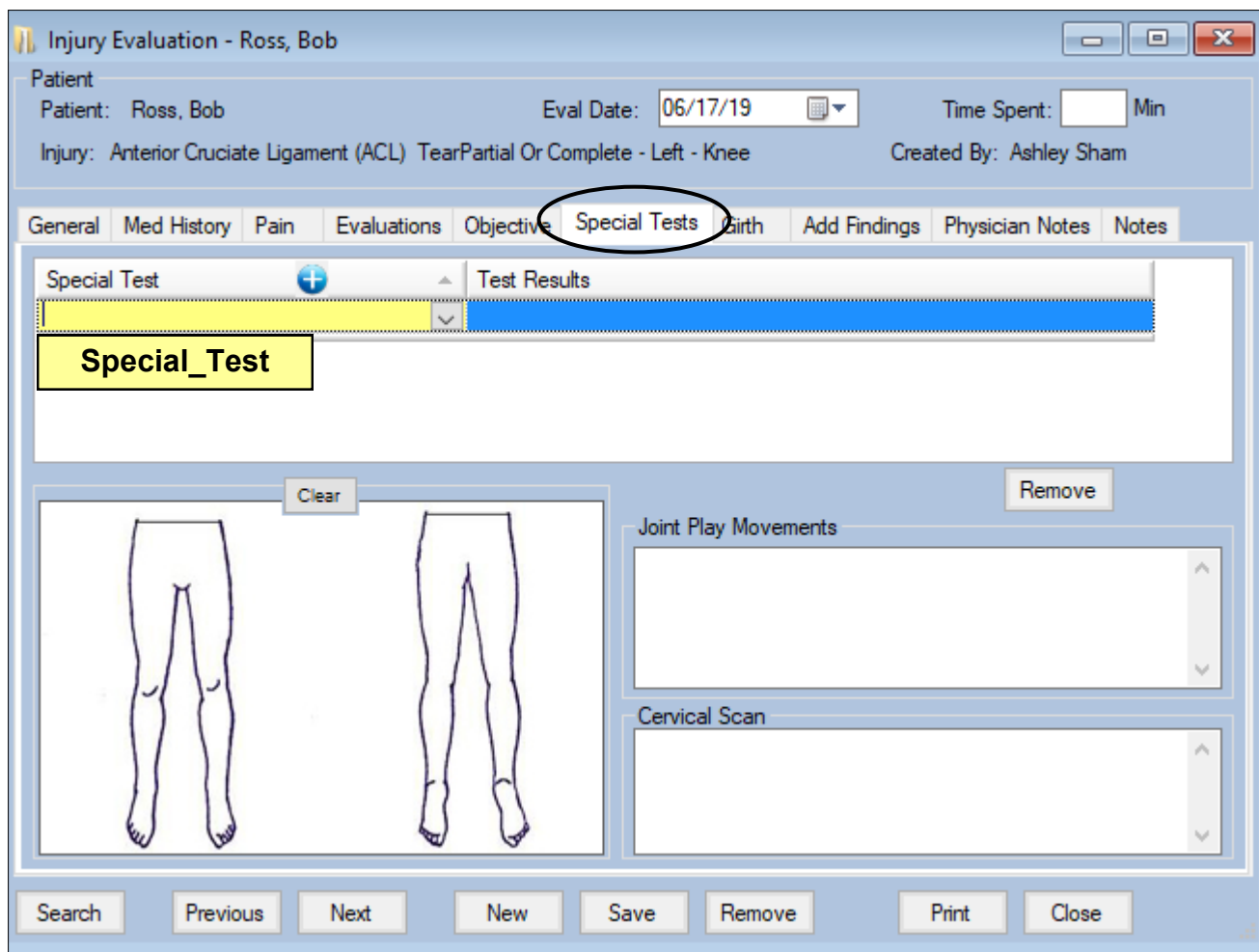

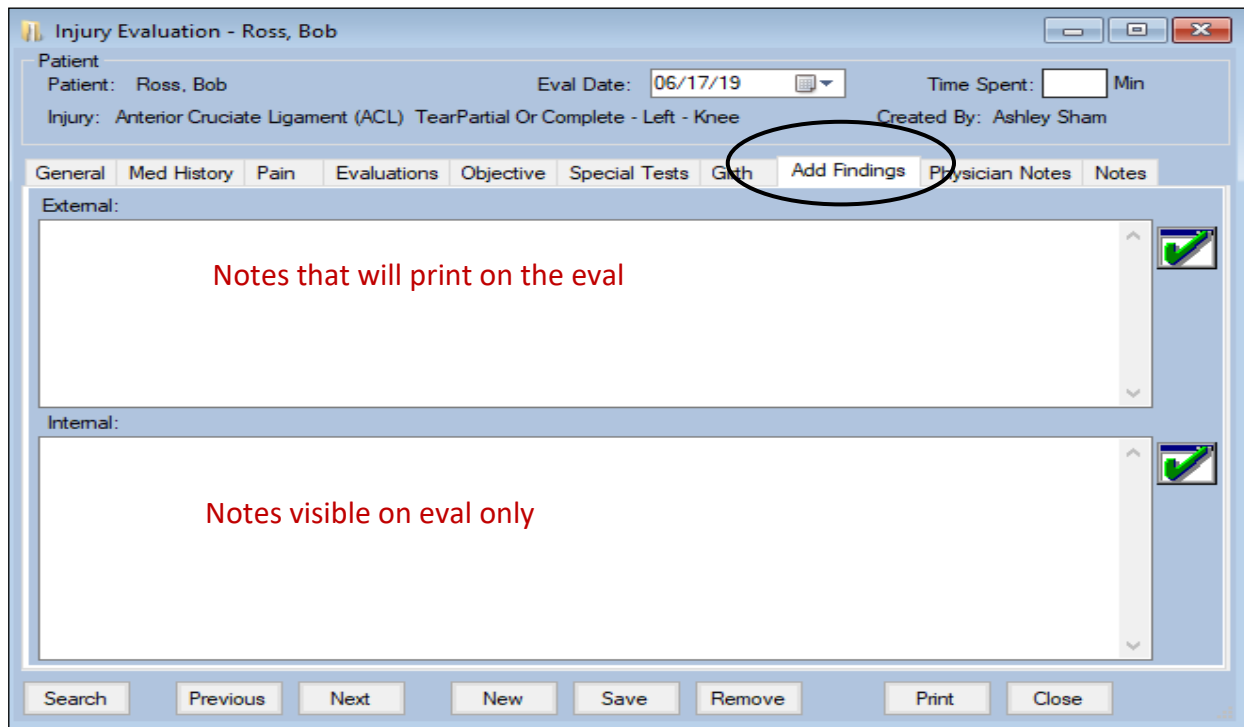

Document your measurement and any notes you wish to make in the designated areas.

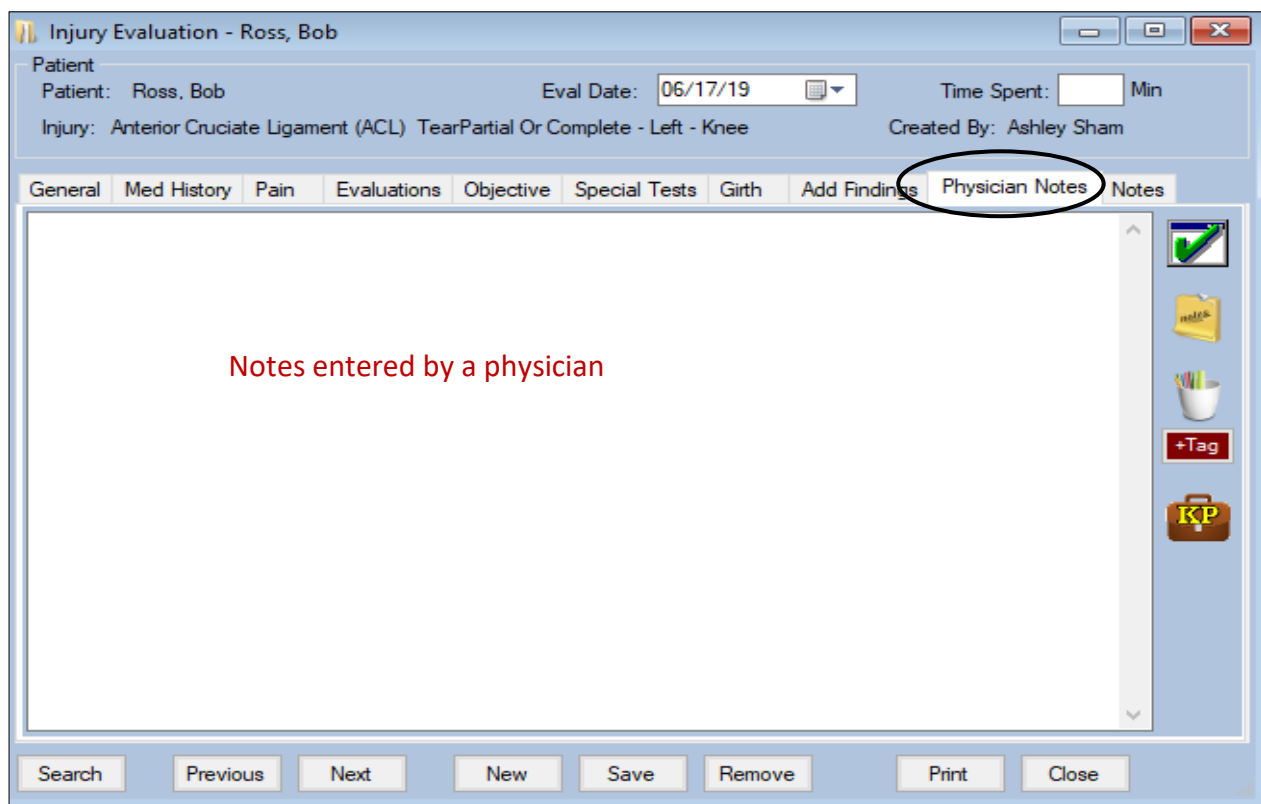
Add Find-

This area will allow you to add a specific note to the evaluation. The notes available are based on the note types custom to your database.

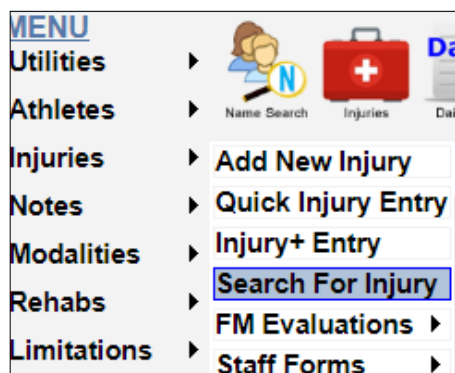

Core Portal



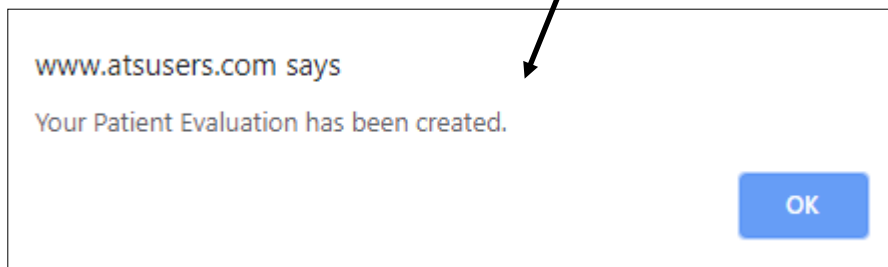

The Core Portal Evaluation has the same tabs, in the same order and collects the same information as the Core Version.
